June: Conservation of the Manx National Heritage Collections. Join MNH Collections Conservation Manager Christopher Weeks in the galleries of the Manx Museum to learn about the amazing conservation of some iconic objects.

July: Join us for a special guided tour of the beautiful gardens at Rushen Abbey with Philip Payne, Horticultural Manager for Manx National Heritage. Discover how naturalistic planting enhances the historic setting, learn about the carefully selected plant species, and gain insight into the evolving design of this tranquil space. This is a fantastic opportunity to explore the gardens in their peak season and hear directly from the horticulturist responsible for their care.

August: The 1961 TT Races. Honda recently supplied to MNH a documentary made by their own Honda archives. The first part of the talk by MNH Curator Matthew Richardson will introduce the main characters followed by a screening of the full 30-minute documentary.

September: Bride and Jurby Gems. Illustrated talk by MNH Archivist Wendy Thirkettle using resources from the library's collections to illuminate these parishes' fascinating history.

October: Living With the Wire - Internment in the First World War. Yvonne Cresswell's talks about internment are always informative and entertaining. Last year we enjoyed learning about Internment in the Second World War. This year we will be travelling back to the Great War.

November: The Isle of Man's National Treasures with Allison Fox. Join MNH Curator: Archaeology Allison Fox at the House of Manannan to learn the hidden stories behind some of the Island's most stunning archaeological artefacts.

December: Watch and Ward on the Isle of Man. Rescheduled from last year, Andrew Johnson, MNH Curator of Archaeology's talk will offer documentary and landscape perspectives on a medieval and post-medieval coastal watch system.
