The understanding of the Isle of Man's rich Viking legacy has been further enhanced by the discovery of the Island's latest treasure hoard – a rare fragment of gold arm-ring which belonged to a Viking, who lived on the Isle of Man around one thousand years ago. Discovered by metal detectorist Ronald Clucas in spring 2025, the
